OVERVIEW

Founded in 1964, The Brookline Arts Center (BAC) provides classes in the visual arts to residents throughout Brookline and Greater Boston. At 55 years old, the BAC continues to have a reputation for being one of the most forward-thinking arts centers around. In addition to regular classes for children age 18 months through adults, the BAC hosts gallery exhibitions, community open houses, several outreach projects, workshops, and the creation of public art.

ART OFF THE WALL

As a small nonprofit, we are committed to developing community and fundraising events that are consistent with our focus and our mission. We are thrilled to present our fifth annual ART Off The Wall, an exhibition and fundraiser, Saturday, May 11 from 6:30-9:00PM. ART Off The Wall features works by artists who support the mission of the BAC. Annually, 20+ artists donate their work. The exhibition culminates in a wonderfully thrilling evening of art, where everyone who holds a Collector's Ticket will have the opportunity to take home a piece of art from the collection.

Proceeds from this event directly support the BAC's outreach programs. We serve 5,000 children, teens and adults annually through our classes, workshops, gallery exhibitions, events and outreach initiatives.

BERLINER AWARD

Each year during the event, the BAC presents the Berliner Award to one deserving individual. This year, we are thrilled to honor Senator Cynthia Creem in recognition of her deep commitment to our mission and support of our Art and Autism program. The Berliner Award, named after BAC founders Mim and Barney Berliner, serves to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions to art and our community and their embodiment of our founders' vision.
