



The Brookline Arts Center (BAC) was founded in 1964 in the basement of Mim and Barney Berliner's St. Paul Street home. With a few neighbors and a strong desire to provide meaningful art education to children, the Berliners opened their home and started this unique program.

Now, in a 132 year old firehouse in the St. Mary's neighborhood, the BAC offers year round classes in Jewelry and Metals, Pottery, Painting, Batik, Characters and Comics, Sensory Play and more. Students are 2 to 92.

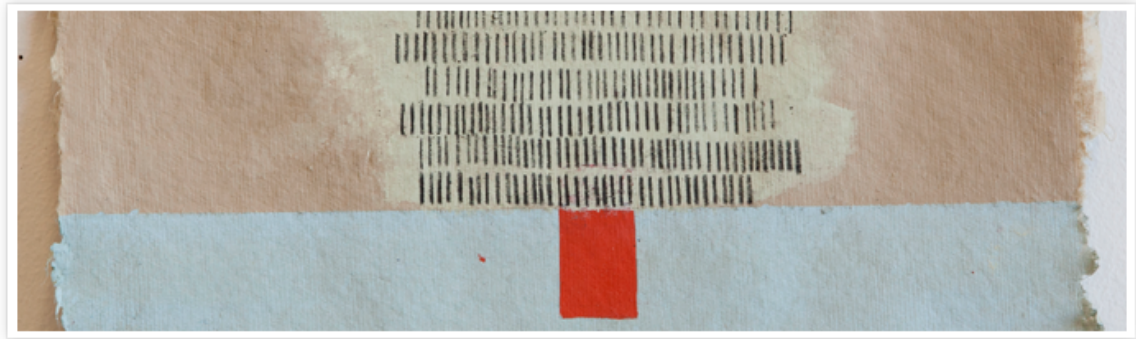
