



Art Teacher: Ages 18mo-4 Part-time Position

The Brookline Arts Center (BAC) is seeking an art teacher to work with children ages 18mo-4 beginning this Fall. The teacher will be responsible for providing overall class goals and objectives, developing class content and curriculum and providing a nurturing environment for children and families. Position may require occasional weekend work as needed.

Classes are offered as follows:

Sensory Play

Day: Monday

Time: 9:30-11:00am

You and your child will use materials such as paper, sand, water and playdough to explore a variety of textures. This play ignites the imagination, as well as encourages and cultivates group socialization. No class 10/9. **September 18-December 11**

Creation Station

Day: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday

Time: 1:15-2:15pm (M), 12:30-2:00pm (W, TH)

The classroom is transformed into an experimental space for creating. Each week, stations are set up for students to play with a variety of materials. Stations have both 2D and 3D materials including paper, playdough, paint, fabric and more! Caretakers must stay for the duration of the class. No class 10/9, 11/22, 11/23. **September 18-December 11 (M), September 20-December 13 (W), September 28-December 14 (TH)**

Art with Movement and Music

Day: Tuesday, Wednesday

Time: 9:30-11:00am



You and your child will explore music and dance through the mediums of visual arts, engaging stories and games. We will paint with our feet, decorate handmade instruments and drum to our own creative beat. Enhance your child's curiosity, and build observation and auditory skills in a class that combines art, music and dance. No class 11/22. **September 19-December 5 (T), September 20-December 13 (W)**

Artistic Journeys

Day: Thursday

Time: 9:30-11:00am

You and your child will explore a different theme each week with a variety of 2D and 3D materials! Create sculptures, collages, puppets, costumes, drawings and paintings inspired by the ocean, ancient worlds and more. No class 11/23. **September 28-December 14**
