During the summer, classes for children and teens are offered as weeklong intensives from 9:00am-2:00pm. Classes for adults are offered in the evening from 6:00-9:00pm.

During the fall, winter and spring, classes meet during the week in the mornings, afterschool, evenings and Saturday and Sunday mornings.
