



## **Jewelry and Metals Teacher Part-time Position**

Students gain hands on knowledge of jewelry making and metalsmithing techniques including soldering, piercing, etching and embellishing in copper, nickel and brass.

Opportunities for instruction of our summer teen intensive classes are available as well. Summer classes run weekly, Monday-Friday from 9:00am-2:00pm and again at 2:30pm-5:30pm, from mid-June through the end of August.
